### Facility Management Co Tenon Acquires UK's O&G for ₹65 cr

**Mumbai:** Facility management services provider Tenon Group has acquired UK's Office and General (O&G) Group for ₹65 crore. The cash and equity deal gives the Tenon Group an opportunity to expand its footprint in the European market.

"We will look for further acquisition opportunities in matured markets in the UK and the US," said Major Manjith Rajain, founder and managing director of the company in a telephonic interview with **ET**. According to him, the company is in talks with private equity investors to raise capital for acquisitions in the domestic market too.



O&G deals with commercial and office facility management encompassing soft and hard services in the UK. It serves universities and the Ministry of Defence besides other sectors. The company is headquartered in London with offices in Manchester and Wolverhampton.

Founded in 1995, Tenon has grown from being a security services provider to a full-fledged facility management services provider. With this acquisition of O&G, the total revenue of the combined entity is now more than ₹1,000 crore, the company said.
